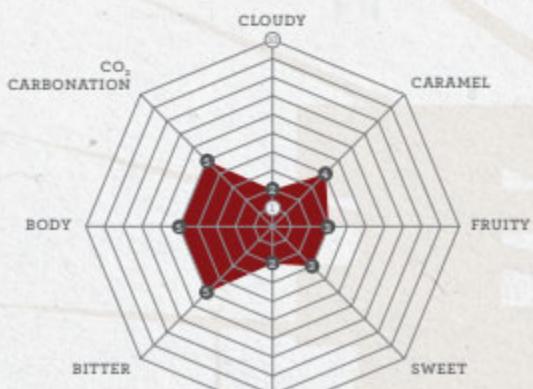

APA - Antwerp Pale Ale
Intense mahogany colour with impressive and robust head.
The aroma is complex with notes of biscuit, chestnut and unmistakable caramel. The beer smells slightly smoked which is nicely balanced by a clear fruitiness, and a herbal note of hop from the noble hop varieties used.

TASTE

All this comes back in the taste, which is pleasantly smooth, with a nuttiness on the tongue. De Koninck is relatively bitter, but the bitterness does not stay long and ends in full, creamy aftertaste.
